BEST PRACTICE

Title of the Practice: Segregation of Students on the basis of their Ability of Learning.

Objective of the practice:

- ▷ By exclusively working on slow learners to improve the overall passing percentage
- ▷ By specially focusing on high achievers to upgrade their performance with a target of securing position in AKTU merit.

Context:

- ▷ The College works on its mission to provide an educational experience rich in theoretical foundations to each student focusing on student centric teaching.
- ▷ Each student has a different psychology and should be handled differently. The department provides student centric teaching keeping in view the ability of learning of each student.

The Practice:

- ▷ Segregation of students is done as per their knowledge level, academic performance and their ability of learning.
- ▷ Grouping students as per their ability increases student achievement by allowing teachers to adjust the pace of instruction as per students' needs.
- ▷ A teacher instructs at a slower pace-providing more repetition and reinforcement-with a group of low-achieving students

Implementation of the Practice:

- ▷ The students having poor academic performance and very good academic performance are identified in the beginning of the session through tests.
- ▷ Special sections (Slow learners/low achievers section and high achievers section) are formed to assist these students as per their academic performance.
- ▷ In Slow learners' section, classes are conducted keeping in view the difficulties that the students are facing in learning/understanding the topic.

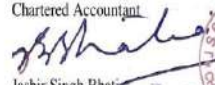
